Maps and air photos can be very useful resources when researching the history of your home and other properties. This session will look at the various types of maps and air photos held by UGA's Map and Government Information Library, including Sanborn Fire Insurance Maps, U.S. Geological Survey maps, and Georgia county highway maps, and discuss how they can be used to determine when your house was built.

Hallie Pritchett has been a member of the University of Georgia Libraries' faculty for almost 10 years and is currently Head of the Map and Government Information Library (MAGIL). MAGIL is a regional Federal Depository Library, the official repository for Georgia state government publications, and home to one of the largest academic map collections in the country.
